

List of Grants allotted by the Government

Robolab Technologies Pvt. Ltd

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MODROB:-

- To equip technical institutions with modern infrastructural facilities in laboratory(s)/workshop(s)/computing facilities to enhance functional efficiency for teaching, training and research purposes.
- Creation of new laboratories is not envisaged.
- Duration -1 year and Limit-20 lakhs.
- Outcome-Modernization of existing Laboratories of AICTE approved Institutions.

Margadarshan Abhiyaan

- Duration-3yrs and funding-50 lakhs.
- The fund, so released shall be utilized to conduct programmes for technical upliftment of the Faculties .

National facility with industrial collaboration(Nafetic):-

- Promoting exchange of information with technical institutions and teachers on significant issues .
- Organizing short-term training programmes for teachers and technical professionals.
- Organizing exhibitions / melas / jathas for promoting technology.
- Duration-3yrs and funding-50 lakhs.
- Outcome-Provide state of art R&D facilities, high end testing and design facilities and facility is required to be self-supporting after completion of the project.

Research Promotion Scheme(RPS):-

RPS aims to create research ambience by promoting research in technical disciplines and innovations; and to generate Master's and Doctoral degree candidates.

Funding for such projects would be limited to a one time grant of Rs. 5-10 lakhs.

Capacity Building for research – A young faculty (30 years limit) with grant of Rs. 10-12 lakhs, is encouraged to carry out research at Doctoral level in a reputed institution.

Patentable technology development by a group of faculty members, who aim at developing new research facilities, at the parent institution. Funding to such projects would be limited to a one time grant of Rs. 20 lakhs.

Industry Institute Interaction Scheme:-

- Conduct of industrial training programmes.
- Facilitating exchange of resource personnel and carry out industrial R&D .
- Conduct of industrial visits
- Developing appropriate curricula and undertake consultancy services.
- Duration-2yrs and Limit-15 lakhs.
- Outcome-Establishment of IIPC and good interaction with industry experts and should be self-sustainable after two years.

Faculty Development Program (FDP):

- Enhance their teaching and other skills, make them aware about modern teaching tools and methodologies.
- Acquire knowledge about current technological developments in relevant fields.
- Channelize development with respect to academic qualifications and personal matters.
- Duration - 2 weeks and Limit of Funding 7 Lakhs,(minimum 50 participants x 2 weeks x7000 per participant per week)
- Expected Outcome- Enhance quality of teachers, facilitate career progression and faculty development.

Summer Winter School Scheme (SWSS):

- enhance their teaching and other skills make them aware about modern teaching tools and methodologies.
- Acquire knowledge about current technological developments in relevant fields.
- Impart professional practices relevant to technical education.
- Achieve competitive teaching and learning environment .
- Duration-2 weeks and limit of funding-7 lakhs.
- Expected Outcome- Enhance quality of teachers, facilitate career progression and faculty development.

Finishing School Scheme (FSS):

Duration-8 weeks after graduation and 12 weeks for students who are currently enrolled.

Limit of Funding 2 Lakhs for batch of 30 students.

Expected Outcome -To enhance quality of students so that they become better employable.
